
Kawa Whakaruruhau: Cultural Safety policy

Launched April 2023


Designed in collaboration with the sector–received feedback from many including the Physiotherapy board of NZ

Companion document to policy


Updated in 2022 to reflect current sector approaches

Supports health providers to deliver culturally safe care








Expectations and responsibilities

It sets out our expectations of providers and suppliers






Meeting the requirements of the policy


Read and engage with both the policy and guidance (designed to be read together)

Embed cultural safety across key business processes


Increase employment opportunities for cultural groups


Ensure regular and mandatory cultural safety training is required

Cultivate community linkages


